### Pre-Camp Responsibilities

- Work with the Camp Director, Head Counselor, and Social Worker to review pre-camp forms and prepare detailed camper profiles.
- Coordinate with the Schedule Director to finalize schedule specifics and logistics.
- Partner with the Night Activity Director to plan and prepare nighttime programming.
- Plan all parts of camp with Boys Head Counselor
- Sign on the camp
- Plans the Chinuch of camp

### In-Camp Responsibilities

- Run daily full-staff meetings to review schedules, expectations, and daily priorities.
- Create and manage the nightly "COD" (Counselor on Duty) schedule.
- Oversee and run meals, ensuring smooth transitions, staffing coverage, and camper supervision.
- Directly oversee cabin cleanliness and organization, including daily checks and follow-through with counselors.
- Execute trips
