

Boys Chinuch Head

The Chinuch Head leads the educational and spiritual life of camp, ensuring meaningful learning and inspiration for campers and staff. This role collaborates with the Leadership Team to integrate Torah, Tzionut, and Middot into all aspects of camp life.

Pre-Camp Responsibilities

- Create a daily learning booklet (18 lessons) for campers entering grades 4–10, with age-appropriate curricula focused on Torah, Tzionut, and Middot.
- Design havruta/habura-style learning sheets for the three Shabbatot of camp.
- Collaborate with the Leadership Team to align all educational programming with the camp's mission and vision.

In-Camp Responsibilities

- Mentor and support program staff, providing guidance and tools to help them succeed in teaching and camper engagement.
- Develop and facilitate meaningful learning opportunities for staff, including pre-tefillah sessions (COCOA Club).
- Lead the religious atmosphere (avira) of camp activities, including tefillot, Kabbalat Shabbat, Havdalah, divrei Torah at communal meals, and special events.
- Serve as Chief Inspirer through teaching, storytelling, and active participation in camp life.
- Assist in organizing and running evening programs and special events.
- Attend and contribute actively to staff meetings and training sessions.
